

Categories and Draw

- Men's Championship 13 players teeing off Match Play Saturday morning. No. 1 seed Tom Lee, No. 2 seed Zach May and Reid Hilton (due to late withdrawal) byes to Saturday afternoon.
- *Women's Championship* 8 players teeing off Match Play Saturday afternoon.
- *Men's Masters Championship* 18 players teeing off qualifying Saturday morning for Matchplay Saturday afternoon qualifying into two divisions of 8.
- *Women's Masters Championship* 3 players teeing off qualifying Saturday morning for Matchplay Sunday morning.
- *Men's Seniors* 7 players teeing off qualifying Saturday morning for Matchplay Saturday afternoon.
- **Boy's U19's** 13 players teeing off qualifying Saturday morning for Matchplay Saturday afternoon qualifying into two divisions of 8 and 5.

Starting Time

Players must report to the tournament office 20 minutes prior to their daily starting time. The Canterbury Golf Hard Card and tournament information will be provided here.

Ties

In the event of a tie for the Match Play qualifying field, positions will be decided on countback.

Matchplay Draw

Will be updated regularly on the whiteboard outside the Pro Shop. The Match Play trees will also be uploaded and updated on the Canterbury Golf website.

COVID Rules

You will also be required to present your Vaccine Pass. Any player unable to present their pass will be removed from the draw. It is compulsory to wear a face mask in the Pro Shop and Clubhouse when not seated.

Code of Conduct

The Canterbury Golf Code of Conduct will apply. Please note the use of drugs and alcohol is prohibited on the course. The code of conduct can be viewed on the Canterbury Golf website.
