STARTING TIME

Players must to the tournament desk in the foyer of the Members Lounge on Saturday where you will be provided with the Canterbury Golf Hard Card and tournament information. Scorecards and pin placements will be provided on the tee.

DRAW

The seeded draw for Sunday will be available on www.canterburygolf.co.nz by 8pm Saturday.

SCORECARDS

Players must read through scores at the scorer's table at the completion of their round located in the Members lounge foyer.

RULES OF PLAY

The 2019 R&A Rules of Golf will be in play as well as the Canterbury Golf Hard Card.

TIES

In the event of a tie for the gross Championship titles the winner will be decided by a 'sudden death' play off. All other results will be determined by countback.

DISPUTES
