TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

FORMAT

54 hole stroke play (36 holes Saturday, 18 holes Sunday)

TEES

Men - Black Tees, Men's Masters - Blue Tees, Women - Yellow Tees

STARTING TIME

Players must report to the Tournament Office on the side of the Pro Shop complex on Saturday 30 minutes prior to tee off where you will be provided with the Canterbury Golf Hard Card and tournament information. Scorecards and pin placements will be provided on the tee.

You will also be required to present your Vaccine Pass. Any player unable to present their pass will be removed from the draw.

It is compulsory to wear a face mask in the Pro Shop and Clubhouse when not seated.

DRAW

The seeded draw for Sunday will be available on www.canterburygolf.co.nz by 8pm Saturday.

SCORECARDS

Players are asked to read through their scores with their marker at the completion of their round located and submit the cards to the Tournament Office.

RULES OF PLAY

The 2019 R&A Rules of Golf will be in play as well as the Canterbury Golf Hard Card. Note that placing is not permitted.

TIES

In the event of a tie for the gross Championship titles the winner will be decided by a 'sudden death' play off. All other results will be determined by countback.

DISPUTES

Disputes or protests must be lodged with Tournament Director immediately upon completion of the round. These will be handled by the Disputes Committee and the Committee decision shall be final.

PRIZE GIVING

The Prize giving will take place in the Members Lounge following the completion of play on Sunday.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The Canterbury Golf Code of Conduct will apply. Please note the use of drugs and alcohol is prohibited on the course. The code of conduct can be viewed on the Canterbury Golf website.
