## **2018 Lamb & Hayward Canterbury Strokeplay Tournament Information**

### **Starting Time**

Players must report to the tournament office 20 minutes prior to their daily starting time. The Canterbury Golf Hard Card, and tournament information will be provided here. Cards will be provided on the tee.

### **Draw**

The seeded draw for Sunday will be available on [www.canterburygolf.co.nz](http://www.canterburygolf.co.nz) by 8pm Saturday.

### **Scorecards**

Players must read through scores at the scorer's table located between the Proshop and clubhouse at the completion of their round. Any changes made must be initialled by the marker. This is compulsory.

### **Rules of Play**

Rules of play shall be the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews. The Canterbury Golf Hard Card is being used and applies, along with the following:

### **Local Rules**

*Placing* – 30cm on closely mown areas.

*GUR* - will be marked with white lines.

*Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1* are modified as follows:

When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment. The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1.

This Local Rule applies only when the player's ball or ball-marker lies on the putting green and any movement is accidental.

Note: If it is determined that a player's ball on the putting green was moved as a result of wind, water or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location. A ball-marker moved in such circumstances is replaced."

### **Ties**

In the event of a tie for the gross trophies, the winner will be decided by a 'sudden death' play off. In the event of a tie for any of the other trophies, the winner will be decided on a countback.

### **Disputes**

Disputes or protests must be lodged with Tournament Director Dennis Maguire immediately upon completion of the round. These will be handled by the Disputes Committee and the Committee decision shall be final.

### **Slow Play – will not be tolerated**

The Canterbury Golf Incorporated Policy on slow play will be enforced – if a warning to a player is not heeded, a one stroke penalty will be imposed for the 1<sup>st</sup> offence, a two stroke penalty for a 2<sup>nd</sup> offence, and any subsequent offence will result in the player's disqualification.

### **Prize giving**

Prize giving is in the clubhouse about half an hour after the last group finishes on Sunday.

### **Code of Conduct**

The Canterbury Golf Code of Conduct will apply. Please note the use of drugs and alcohol is prohibited on the course. The code of conduct can be viewed on the Canterbury Golf website.
