## GOLF NATION ROADSHOW IN CHCH – 15 JULY

The well publicised New Zealand Golf 'Golf Nation' concept will be presented to Canterbury golf clubs and administrators on Tuesday 15 July at the Russley Golf Club (6.30pm start).

The presentation of the 'Golf Nation' concept will be made by Dean Murphy (Commercial Manager) and Bill MacGowan (Chief Executive) from New Zealand Golf.

The Golf Nation programme will target casual and green fee paying golfers, with the aim of converting these golfers to club members. The programme is based on survey research of 2500 casual golfers across New Zealand. Also as part of the research undertaken by NZ Golf, a toolkit will be provided to all golf clubs in New Zealand highlighting the findings of the research, and highlight key areas that clubs can address to improve membership levels.

All clubs have been invited by NZ Golf to send representatives to Russley Golf Club on 15 July.

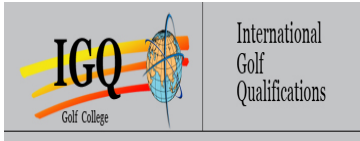
## BOYLE CUP DEFENCE – Waitikiri Golf Club
