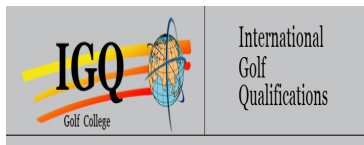

The Golf Scholarship is a comprehensive programme which offers recipients full academic funding, year-long golf specific physical training programmes, along with coaching and tournament support from Canterbury Golf. The Scholarship is worth approximately \$12,000 per year for each scholar.
