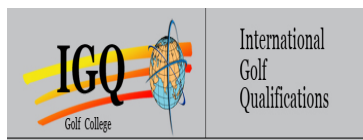

CGI U19 Coaching Day – Monday 6 October

CGI Coaching & Development Manager Karen de Lautour has coordinated a coaching day at Clearwater on Monday 6 October for 100 under 19 golfers nominated by CGI Clubs.

NZPGA Professional Coach Jason Tilley will run the coaching side of the day along with a number of other Canterbury based Professional Coaches. The day will focus on offering coaching support to junior golfers in the 6+ handicap bracket, and this day will form part of a programme that will offer coaching support to junior golfers at both elite and non-elite levels. The day will also be supported by a number of invited guests who will offer support and advice to the junior golfers in attendance, including Gregg Thorpe - NZ Golf Manager of Coach Development and Junior Golf.

Plans are also forming for additional coaching days and camps with smaller groups of elite players (scratch to 5 handicaps), aligning with NZ Golf programmes and pathways.
