You may wish to do this course as a refresher or to upgrade your grading. There is a qualification of Pass with Honours for those who score 90% or more in the examination set by the New Zealand Golf Association. The examination as from 2003 is of a different format. There are six Sections, Table Questions, Situation/Rule Questions, Structured Questions, Multiple Choice Questions, and Diagram Questions.

The Assignments are new this year as too are the various tests included with the work.
