

SOUTH ISLAND INTERPROVINCIAL TOURNAMENT HISTORY - CANTERBURY

The Women's South Island Interprovincial tournament was played for in 1986 with the original teams being Canterbury, South Canterbury, Otago & Southland. In 1990 the Barbara Langley trophy was first presented. The tournament was renamed to the Women's South Island Interprovincial in 2010 with the addition of Tasman.

Canterbury has won the event a record 27 times, with a record sequence of 14 wins in a row between 2005-2018. Below is a record of all the tournaments and the winning province.
